3rd partner meeting was held on 9th and 10th of September in Rijeka, Croatia where all partners agreed on upcoming activities under the project:

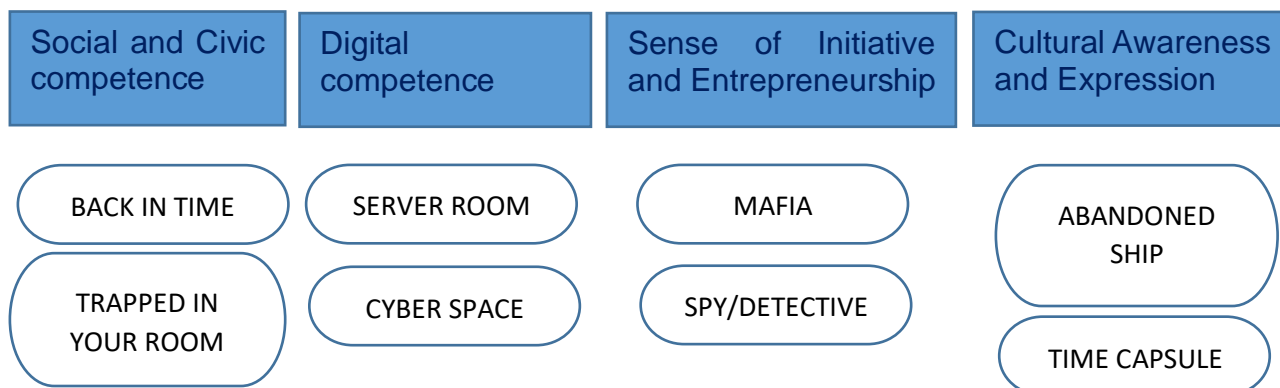
- how to make escape rooms more engaging in this final production process
- integration of 32 escape room resources on the project website
- development of the in-service training resources
- support in all development work by testing the training materials with stakeholder forums in each partner country
- in service training program curriculum and 5 hours introductory workshop on national level



NEET-SYSTEM is a consortium of 9 partners representing: Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Finland, Germany, Ireland, Poland, Switzerland and United Kingdom

WHAT HAPPENED IN THE 1st YEAR OF THE PROJECT?

From September 2018 until September 2019, partners have been working in groups developing 32 escape room resources. Resources were developed at 4 different levels: **Introductory, Intermediate, Advanced and Expert level** with 2 resources per competence:



RESULT: a suite of 32 escape room exercises that are now ready for

testing with stakeholders, translating into partners language and producing media rich formats for all escape rooms
