Online Observatory is Launched!

As part of the VAL.oR project, partners aimed to work with local festival committees to produce a range of national case studies and show case profiles of successful festivals. These showcases comprise video interviews, audio interviews and written case studies. Over the last few months, partners in Bulgaria, Ireland, Italy, Romania, Finland and Portugal have been conducting interviews with local festival organisers to learn of the supports they received when setting up their festival, what motivated them to establish the festival and what their plans are for the future. The first results are now ready to be presented online through a bespoke online observatory. At the meeting in Lousada, partners swapped ideas about how they will plan and deliver training and animation events in local communities to raise awareness of the VALoR project. These training and dissemination events will give partners a unique opportunity to animate and involve local volunteers in planning successful cultural events and festivals. At these events, partners also plan to deliver the mentoring programme, which will match experienced volunteers with new-recruits to ensure the continued success of local cultural events. The first round of training in Ireland for festival organisers is planned for May, 2019; with partners in Italy, Romania, Bulgaria and Portugal planning to deliver training through informal workshops and blended learning over the summer months.
