“Calendar for Climate Change” Erasmus+ funded project aims to creatively tackle two important societal issues simultaneously – the lack of climate change awareness and the disengagement in society that senior citizens endure after retirement. It is a 2 year project running from 01-11-2021 to 31-10-2023.

MAIN AIMS

Calendar for Climate Change will provide seniors with the opportunity to exchange their tacit knowledge with today’s ‘tech savvy’ digital native population in exchange for the technical know-how that the younger generations take for granted.

While senior learners can help to address this need of younger learners for support and direction in their fight against climate change, young people can support senior learners through introducing them to new and emerging technology platforms that can help them to prepare for and engage with the digital transition that is sweeping across European society.

OBJECTIVES \ RESULTS

The result will be the development of an interactive calendar, with training resources that support the implementation of 12 high-tech climate change solutions and 12 low-tech climate change solutions – meaning one high-tech and low-tech solution for each month of the year!

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KICK-OFF MEETING
