ABOUT

SPIRITUS LOCI is an EU funded project aiming at recovering a physical and spiritual experience of space through art and at fostering the dialogue of memories, lights, shadows and new needs, facilitating the readjustment between the person, the collective and its place

GOAL

The specific objective is to develop an innovative and creative experiential learning pathway for adults, more or less young, interested in the cultural life of their places, aimed at the realization of a cultural and artistic event in the four pilot sites: Italy, Greece, Germany and Lithuania.

This learning process is widely supported by new information and communication technologies and characterised by an inclusive methodological approach oriented towards the acquisition of key competences for active and participatory citizenship





PROGRESS & NEXT STEPS

A lot has been happening in the Spiritus Loci project over the past few months. After the consortium completed two trainings on the ICAMS method and video design, we entered the development phase of the individual modules for the first intellectual output, the "Education to Beauty Curriculum". In December, an online brainstorming session was held to exchange ideas and explore shared approaches. In January, the revised drafts were presented by the individual partners and discussed among the consortium, so that some modules are almost completed. Major progress can be expected from the other modules in the coming weeks. This will be followed by a translation into all national languages of the participating organisations. In the same time, we hope to start the pilot phase and to put the developed modules into a first testing and evaluation loop at the respective locations. Furthermore, the project website is in development.
